SUBJECT: Incremental Risk Assessment for Ortho Triforine EC (239-2455)

The Ecological Effects Branch has completed its review of the proposed changes to the uses of Ortho Triforine EC. The proposed changes are:

1. Increase the rate of application from 10 to 12 fl oz per 100 gal to 12 to 16 fl oz per 100 gal for roses.
2. Add application for asters in California only using 10 to 18 fl. oz. per 100 gals.

These changes are recommended for conditional registration as they are not expected to result in either exposure to new populations (wildlife or plants) not previously exposed or increased exposure to the populations that are risks from currently registered uses.
