

Conclusion

LD₅₀ was estimated as in excess of 25mg/kg.

Materials

PP 581 (brodifacoum)

Castrated sheep (30-35kg)

Methods

Compound was administered orally by drench, in polyethylene glycol, to two sheep at 25mg/kg. Animals were observed for three weeks and then necropsied.

Results

No toxic effects were observed. LD₅₀ was estimated as in excess of 25mg/kg.
