Recommendations:

1. The registrant has provided some toxicological evidence and expected exposure to applicators to substantiate the position that 21-day dermal exposure studies are not needed. Toxicology Branch does not concur with this conclusion due to the fact that persons can come in contact with the treated turf on a daily basis, e.g., children playing on the lawn. Therefore the requirement for ²¹12-day subacute dermal toxicity studies remains unchanged.
