We have reviewed your August 1, 1994 waiver request for a goat metabolism study conducted with sodium acifluorfen radiolabelled in the chlorophenyl ring.

We approve the waiver of these additional data for guideline requirement 171-4(b). Metabolism of sodium acifluorfen in the goat is not expected to cleave the diphenylether bond. A copy of our review is enclosed.
