ICI Americas has requested to use acetochlor experimentally throughout the United States. In a previous review (dated January 13, 1993; D182797), EEB indicated that effects to endangered plants and fish would be expected where use proposed, is adjacent to habitat where these species occur.

The attached list includes those counties where ICI hopes to use acetochlor the earliest in the 1993 growing season. The EEB has considered those counties first in their search for potential species that may be affected. The following are those counties where endangered plant or fish species occur. The species are also identified.

If the registrant uses acetochlor experimentally in the other counties on the list and not in these, effects to endangered species would not be expected. If the registrant can determine that the specific locations where they want to use acetochlor in the 5 counties listed above is not near any endangered plants or fish, they may submit that information for EEB concurrence.
