We have reviewed your residue chemistry and toxicology portions of the above subject letter date and conclude the following:

RESIDUE CHEMISTRY REVIEW

1. You must provide adequate residue data for the proposed layby application rate of 1.25 lbs a.i./A and 40 day PHI. Alternatively, you may wish to amend Section B Use Directions for the layby treatment to provide a maximum of 1.0 lbs. a.i./A and 65 day PHI.
2. The label restriction "Do not allow livestock to graze on treated cotton forage or trash, or feed treated cotton forage or trash to livestock" must be moved to the Restrictions section of the label.

TOXICOLOGY REVIEW

Toxicology has no objections provided that the addition of this tolerance will not result in the tolerances exceeding 100% of the RfD.
