The Ecological Effects Branch (EEB) has reviewed a protocol from FMC Corporation for a fathead minnow full life-cycle study. The test will be conducted on technical (88.35% ai) biphenthrin as requested by EPA on March 28, 1984. This was later confirmed during a telephone conversation with Les Touart on May 20, 1986.

The protocol and addendum are acceptable to EEB. objective of the study is to assess growth and production of fathead minnows in order to determine the Maximum Acceptable Toxicant Concentration (MATC) for biphenthrin. This will be acheived by defining the chemical effects on hatchability and viability of eggs, number of spawns and eggs per adult and growth of fish as determined by comparison between controls and exposure concentrations using acceptable statistical methods. The protocol outlines the procedure and methods used to acheive the above objectives.
