

ENTOMOLOGIST'S COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

The data cited are not for γ -cyhalothrin, but rather λ -cyhalothrin. The effectiveness of γ -cyhalothrin can reasonably be expected to exceed that of λ -cyhalothrin, as the insecticidally active isomer is the γ -isomer. Data have neither been submitted nor cited that demonstrating the enhanced efficacy of γ -isomer. Therefore, the cited data have been reviewed and were considered as if they were cited in support of a λ -cyhalothrin formulation. The cited studies have been determined to support the following pests, when applied at a rate of 1 gal/1000 sq. ft.:

1. Ants
 - a. including Fire Ants (*Solenopsis invicta*) at or above 0.03%
 - b. except Carpenter Ants (*Camponotus* spp.) and Pharaoh Ants (*Monomorium pharoanis*)
2. Bedbugs, at or above 0.015%
3. Bees & Wasps, at or above 0.0075%
4. Centipedes, at or above 0.015%
5. Cockroaches, at or above 0.015% (residual claims at or above 0.03%)
6. Fleas, at or above 0.015% (for outdoor use only)
7. Flies, at or above 0.0075%
8. Mosquitoes, at or above 0.03% (for residual claims use 0.06%)
9. Spiders, at or above 0.03%
 - except Black Widow Spiders and Brown Recluse Spiders.
10. Termites (above ground only; not structural protection), at or above 0.0075%
11. Ticks, at or above 0.03%
12. Scorpions, at or above 0.03%
