Ecological Effects Branch is completing its write-up of the latest data submitted for GX-071. The Branch has determined the avian and aquatic studies are adequate to support the registration of this product because of its intended indoor use. To support any outdoor application of this active ingredient, at a minimum the aquatic studies would be considered supplemental (and need to be repeated) and the avian dietary LC50 requirement would have to be satisfied. You may want to inform the registrant on this matter.

The write-up for the pending review will be completed soon and forwarded to your Branch. This memorandum should allow your Division to make a regulatory decision in advance of our formal write-up.
