A. Background

- What is web-distributed labeling (WDL)?
 - Electronic distribution of state-registered labeling via the internet, facsimile, telephone
- Where did the idea originate?
 - States presented topic to OPP Office Director at Summer 2007 AAPCO meeting
- What are the goals of WDL?
 - Simplify container labels by moving portions (e.g., use directions) from container to internet
 - Allow for rapid updating of the labeling



A. Background (cont.)

- In what way is EPA exploring the WDL concept?
 - EPA work group (created fall 2007) drafted “issue papers” and conducted stakeholder outreach
 - PPDC sub group (created May 2008) reviewed and provided comment on EPA work group issue papers
 - Questions on WDL distributed to SFIREG
 - WDL concept has been discussed at many association meetings



A. Background (cont.)

 - Labeling lifespan
 - Alternate delivery mechanisms
 - Education and outreach

- What topics have been discussed since June 2009?
 - Four meetings: 6/23/09, 7/22/09, 9/17/09, 10/13/09
 - Topics Discussed
 - Enforcement
 - Structured labeling
 - Website hosting
 - Benefits
 - Liability
 - Virtual Pilot
 - Future of PPDC sub group



C. Virtual Pilot

- What is the WDL “virtual pilot”?
 - Web-based software application that will simulate the WDL user experience
 - Would allow users to search for/download mock labeling



C. Virtual Pilot (cont.)

- What would be the overall objectives of the pilot?
 - Determine whether a system can be designed that registrants could use to distribute labeling through the internet
 - Determine whether the benefits of WDL would be appealing enough that users would be willing to visit a website to download and read labeling



C. Virtual Pilot (cont.)

- What would be the proposed time line for the virtual pilot?
 - Participant identification ~3 months
 - Pilot execution ~10 months
 - Pilot follow-up ~3 months

Total ~16 months



C. Virtual Pilot (cont.)

- How did the PPDC subgroup respond to EPA's virtual pilot concept paper?
 - Suggested pre-pilot evaluation
 - Conducting an analysis of existing websites would achieve virtual pilot objectives
 - Several expressed concerns about cost
- How did potential vendors respond to EPA's virtual pilot concept paper?
 - Generally interested
 - Technology needed to support virtual pilot is available
 - Potential vendors are eager to demonstrate creativity
