- Lowering expenditures of remediating pesticides in the environment
- Enhancing/stabilizing food supply

Potential Performance Measures for Benefits I. Measures with Data Currently Available

- Economic Loss Avoided Through Section 18 Program
 - Pros: loss measures well developed, data submissions required by program, measure is concrete and understandable
 - Limitations: does not fully measure benefits of registration,
 additional work required to measure all Section 18 submissions
- Benefits of Generic Registration Program
 - Pros: data readily available, concrete and understandable
 - Limitations: pesticide expenditure small portion of production costs, focuses on limited aspect of program

Potential Performance Measures for Benefits II. Measures Requiring Substantial Data Collection

- Trade Opportunities from Harmonization
 - Pros: focus on economically important activity
 - Limitations: difficulties in linking program activities to outcome, data requirements may be challenging, OPP mission focus
- Solid Waste Remediation from Program Activities
 - **Pros:** basis for data collection, waste stream importance
 - Limitations: potentially expensive data collection, focus on limited aspect of solid waste
- Cost Changes for Remediating Pesticides in Water (DW)
 - Pros: drinking water important program focus
 - Limitations: difficulty of data collection, linking program activities to data, scope of measure relative to overall mission

Potential Performance Measures for Benefits III. Measures Requiring New Methods and Data

- Resistance Management
 - Pros: important issue in pesticide (re)registration
 - Limitations: defining/measuring resistance, data collection
- Expenditures on Structural Pest Control/Damage
 - Pros: important economic activity
 - Limitations: data collection
- Incidence and Cost of Vector Borne Illnesses
 - Pros: important issue in pesticide (re)registration
 - Limitations: defining pesticide contribution, data collection
