

A. Provide a brief description of activities, products, etc:		
<p>The original application included the addition of mining acreage to the Stockton, Coalburg, and Haddix coal seams using contour, area, and auger mining methods. The Taylor and Clarion coal seams were added to the project at a later date. Spoil storage areas on the original application included eight hollow fills (Hollow Fills #1-8). Sediment structures for drainage control included Ponds 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 22. Pond 22 is shared, permitted, and bonded by adjacent Permit Nos. 880-7010 and 880-8002.</p> <p>The deletion of Hollow Fill #1 and addition of Hollow Fill #9 has been proposed. They also plan to add Pond 8, 9, and 1-R for sediment and drainage control in Amendment 1.</p> <p>Amendment 2 proposes the addition of contour and auger acreage to the Stockton, Taylor, Coalburg, and Haddix coal seams along with a temporary spoil storage area as part of the mining operation, and the addition of Pond 10.</p>
