

**PUBLIC NOTICE – COMMENT PERIOD EXTENDED TO OCTOBER 14, 2014**

**U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY  
DECISION TO ADD FIFTY-TWO WATERBODY-POLLUTANT COMBINATIONS  
TO NORTH CAROLINA'S 2014 SECTION 303(d) LIST**

Section 303(d)(2) of the Clean Water Act requires that states submit, every two years, lists of waters for which existing pollution controls fail to attain or maintain state water quality standards. The EPA must approve or disapprove each list, referred to as a 303(d) list or list of impaired waters. On July 31, 2014, the EPA partially approved North Carolina's 2014 303(d) list, agreeing with the State's listing of 1,194 waterbody-pollutant combinations as well as the removal of 227 waterbody-pollutant combinations. The EPA also independently determined that 52 additional waterbody-pollutant combinations should have been included and has added those to North Carolina's section 303(d) list.

The EPA welcomes public comments on the decision to add 52 waterbody-pollutant combinations to North Carolina's 2014 303(d) list. **You are invited to submit comments in writing no later than October 14, 2014**, an extension from September 12, 2014, to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 4, Water Protection Division, 61 Forsyth Street, S.W., Atlanta, Georgia 30303-8960, ATTENTION: Ms. Marion Hopkins, Water Quality Planning Branch.
