Generic spray-drift label statements

Azinphos-methyl Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) signed May 23, 2002:

Do not allow spray to drift from the application site and contact people, structures people occupy at any time and the associated property, parks and recreation areas, nontarget crops, aquatic and wetland areas, woodlands, pastures, rangelands, or animals.

Current label submission from azinphos-methyl registrants:

Do not apply this product in a manner inconsistent with the Best Management practices summarized below or that allows spray to drift from the target application site and contact people, regularly occupied structures and the associated property, parks and defined recreation areas, non-target crops, aquatic and wetland areas, woodlands, pastures, rangelands, livestock, pets, or wildlife.

AAPCO interim language:

Do not apply this product in a manner that allows spray to drift from the application target site and/or cause harm to humans, animals, or other non-target sites.

Alternate interim language:

Do not apply this product in a manner that allows spray to drift from the target application site and that may cause adverse effects to humans, animals, or other non-target sites.
