


Subject: Autolivs' Implementation of Project XL as Sponsored by EPA.

The Howell City Town Council has reviewed Autolivs' proposal to burn their waste propellants in the metals recovery facility at the Promontory location. After discussing the project with Autoliv personnel, the council feels that the processing of the waste materials through the air pollution control equipment associated with the metals recovery facility will be a more sound method of destruction than the present method of open burning. 
