Project XL/ENVVEST

- **Empty existing holding sites**
- **Use dredge material for construction blocks & artificial reef material**
- **Streamline dredge permit process**
- **Implement perpetual cycle of using holding sites & manufacture blocks/reef material**
- **Avoid ocean disposal**

Community Involvement

Estimated Timeline

- **Testing of Dredge Material, fly ash** → **January**
- **Draft Final Project Agreement (FPA) & Stakeholder Meeting** → **February**
- **Public Comment Period** → **March**
- **Finalize FPA** → **May**
- **Initiate pilot test** → **September**
