Parts of this report and the accompanying references have been blacked out or whited out (“redacted”) to remove information exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”), 5 U.S.C. § 552(b), specifically:

- Information that could be claimed as confidential business information (e.g., names of certain contractor employees, a contractor’s unit cost for particular services). In the documents, this information is marked “(b)(4),” which refers to the FOIA exemption for confidential commercial information, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(4).
- Information, the release of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. An example is an identifying number, such as a sample location number or laboratory sample number, which could be used to reveal the quality of water in an individual’s privately-owned drinking water well. In the documents, this information is marked “(b)(6),” which refers to the FOIA exemption for private personal information, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6).
- Geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells. In the documents, this information is marked “(b)(9),” which refers to the FOIA exemption for geophysical information, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(9).
