We are pleased to submit our application for revisions to Delaware's authorized hazardous waste management program. The application, comprising a revised Program Description, Attorney General's Statement, Memorandum of Agreement and a copy of *Delaware Regulations Governing Hazardous Waste* has been developed to maintain Delaware's equivalency with the Federal Program as defined by Subtitle C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

On December 14, 1983, Delaware became the first state in the nation to receive full authorization to administer and enforce the base hazardous waste program. This submittal expands Delaware's base program by seeking authorization for the provisions found in Attachment 1 of Delaware's Hazardous Waste Program Description. Authorization of these revisions by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ensures that the interests of Delaware industry and citizens continue to be well represented by the "First State".

I look forward to your approval to continue the implementation of this vital environmental program in Delaware.
