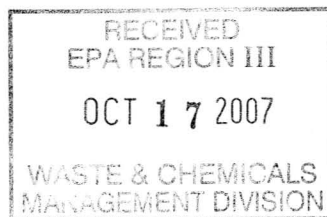

Dear Mr. Welsh:

I am pleased to submit the Commonwealth of Virginia's application for revised authorization for the Virginia Hazardous Waste Management Program. This application includes an Attorney General's Statement, and copies of all applicable statutes and regulations. The Attorney General's Statement has been signed by Senior Assistant Attorney General Roger L. Chaffe on behalf of Attorney General Robert F. McDonnell.

On July 10, 2006, the Commonwealth received approval of Program Revision III to its hazardous waste management program. Since then, the Commonwealth's regulations have been updated to include federal regulatory changes. This application, Program Revision IV, addresses those changes occurring between July 1, 2004 and June 19, 2006. It has been developed to demonstrate continuing equivalency of Virginia's program with the federal program, as defined by Subtitle C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act. No change in the Program Description or Memorandum of Agreement is necessitated by these changes.

I look forward to your approval to continue the implementation of this vital program in the Commonwealth.
