

Enclosed is a copy of the West Virginia Program Description as described in Section 271.6 of 40 CFR part 271. This Program Description describes a program revision of the current program for hazardous waste regulation by the West Virginia governmental agencies charged with those responsibilities. It represents the changes or revisions of the program that have taken place between 1985 and 1997, and is believed to be a complete and final version of the Program Description in response to EPA comments. Also included in this submittal are appendices that were not included with the draft Program Description previously sent.

One of the appendices is the West Virginia Office of Legal Services Statement in fulfillment of 40 CFR Section 271.7.
