Biodiesel Registration

- Registration is via EPA Form 3520-12, Fuel Additive Manufacturer Notification for Motor Vehicle Fuel.

- Also submit: description of raw materials and process, and lab report showing the biodiesel meets ASTM D 6751.

Biodiesel Registration

- Tier 1 health-effects report – you must have permission from the National Biodiesel Board or Nextfuels, Inc. to reference the report in EPA Form 3520-12.
- Tier 2 health-effects report – if you are over \$10 million in annual revenue, you must have permission from the National Biodiesel Board to reference the report in EPA Form 3520-12.
- A separate registration is required for the diesel sulfur program and the renewable fuel standard program via the Central Data Exchange. Please see:
