## PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED ADMINISTRATIVE SETTLEMENT WITH CARTER BUILDING, INC.

In accordance with Section 122(i) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act, as amended (CERCLA), <u>42 U.S.C. 9622(i)</u>, notice is hereby given of a proposed administrative settlement with Carter Building, Inc., St. Louis, Missouri, for the compromise of past and projected future oversight costs concerning the Carter Carburetor Superfund Site in St. Louis, Missouri.

The settlement includes a covenant not to sue with the settling party pursuant to Section 107(a) of CERCLA, <u>42 U.S.C. 9607(a)</u>. Through September 9, 2013, EPA will receive written comments relating to the compromise of costs component of the settlement.

EPA will consider all comments and may modify or withdraw its consent to the settlement if comments received disclose facts or considerations which indicate that the compromise of costs is inappropriate, improper, or inadequate. EPA's response to any comments received will be available for public inspection at the EPA Region 7 office located at 11201 Renner Boulevard, Lenexa, Kansas 66219.
