BMAC Gamma Screening Report

BMAC Final Soil Sampling Report

EPA is finalizing the BMAC soil sampling report, which will include the results of more than 100 soil samples taken the week of May 19, 2014. When final, the report will be available on Region 7's West Lake web page.



Second Interagency Agreement with USACE

EPA is developing a second agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to enlist their expertise for the remedy selection process. The signed agreement will be posted on Region 7's West Lake web page.

USGS Groundwater Review Report

The U.S. Geological Survey is preparing a report reviewing the results of the ground water data collected during the last year. The final report will be posted to Region 7's West Lake web page.
