

# DESIGNATIONS IN US EPA REGION 9 FOR THE 1971 ANNUAL NITROGEN DIOXIDE (NO<sub>2</sub>) NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS

-  Maintenance
-  Cannot be classified or better than national standards

The 1971 primary and secondary national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS) for annual NO<sub>2</sub> are 53 parts per billion (ppb). All areas under EPA Region 9 jurisdiction are designated "Cannot be classified or better than national standards."
