NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY FOR PUBLIC REVIEW**EPA's Action to Add Waters to Arizona's 2010 List of Waters Requiring a Total Maximum Daily Load**

March 4, 2013

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is soliciting public comments on EPA's action to add six waterbody-pollutant combinations to Arizona's 2010 list of waters requiring a total maximum daily load (TMDL). On October 17, 2012, Arizona submitted its list of waters requiring a TMDL under Clean Water Act Section 303(d)(2). Section 303(d)(2) requires that states submit and EPA approve or disapprove lists of waters not meeting water quality standards, where existing technology-based pollution controls are not stringent enough to attain, or maintain, state water quality standards, and for which a TMDL must be prepared.

Arizona identified, in its 2010 303(d) List, various waterbody-pollutant combinations as requiring TMDLs. See, 2010 303(d) list ("2010 Impaired Waters List"), available at the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality web page: <http://www.azdeq.gov/environ/water/assessment/assess.html>

On March 1, 2013, EPA determined that Arizona's list of waters requiring a TMDL partially met the requirements of Clean Water Act Section 303(d), and approved each of the State's listings included in its 2010 303(d) list, Category 5 Waters list. During its review, EPA also identified several waters and associated pollutants that met federal listing requirements but were not included in Arizona's list. Accordingly, EPA has identified additional waterbody-pollutant combinations as requiring a TMDL. This notice announces EPA's action to add the waterbody-pollutant combinations to Arizona's 2010 Section 303(d) list. After considering received public comments, U.S. EPA will make any necessary adjustments to its decision and transmit the final list to the state.
