# ACRES – What's the Purpose?

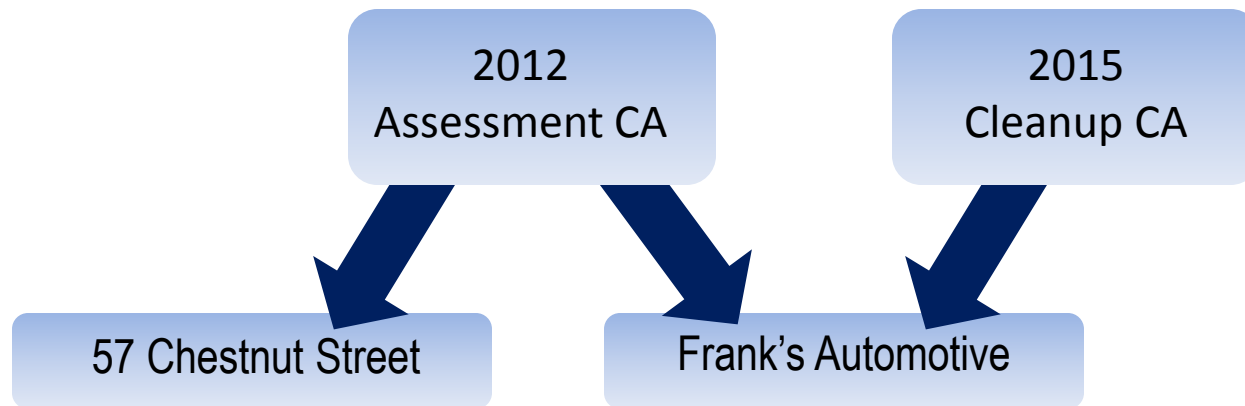


# What Data Do You Report to ACRES?

- ◆ **Geographic information about your sites**
- ◆ **Assessment activities and funding**
- ◆ **Contaminants found and media affected**
- ◆ **State program enrollment**
- ◆ **Cleanup activities and funding**
- ◆ **Redevelopment activities and funding**
- ◆ **Leveraging information**
- ◆ **Property history and ownership information**
- ◆ **Quarterly Report Generation – Cleanup Grants Only**

# How Are Data Organized?

- ◆ Each signed Cooperative Agreement is one record in ACRES
- ◆ A single property record may be associated with more than one grant



# Do I Need to Register? Yes!

- ◆ Follow instructions in your packet/ACRES card
- ◆ Keep your ACRES handouts – You will need them in November!
- ◆ You will need your eight-digit CA number and state abbreviation

- ◆ Contractors can do ACRES - Include ACRES in your RFP/RFQ
