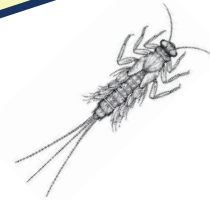

### E.P.T. Taxonomy Workshop

This workshop will focus on genus level taxonomy of Ephemeroptera, Plecoptera, and Trichoptera (E.P.T.) of the north-east region. Mayflies will be specifically highlighted, but information will also be provided on regional genus level diversity of stoneflies and caddisflies. Some of the traditionally difficult to separate taxa will be discussed and some reference material will be available. The overall goal of the workshop is to provide direct taxonomic assistance to participants. Participants are encouraged to bring representative material to work on and any specimens that they would like to ask questions about. Participants should also bring a copy of the 4<sup>th</sup> edition of An Introduction to the Aquatic Insects of North America, or copies of the relevant EPT chapters, and their own scopes, light sources and bench tools (forceps etc.).
