**Administrative Record File Addendum Available for
the Centredale Manor Site Removal Action**

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announces that the Administrative Record File Addendum for the removal action at the Centredale Manor Site located in North Providence, Rhode Island is available for review. EPA seeks to inform the public of the availability of the Administrative Record File Addendum and to encourage the public to review and comment on it. The removal actions proposed for the site include the following: 1) construction of interim protective caps over areas of contaminated soil to control soil migration and prevent human exposure; 2) collection of additional soil samples for site characterization; 3) evaluation of flood conditions and options for flood mitigation; and 4) completion of fence installation. These actions and others are further described in the Action Memorandum Addendum dated 13 September 1999, which is included in the Administrative Record File Addendum available at the locations listed below.

The Administrative Record File is the collection of documents that formed the basis for the selection of a removal action at the site. Documents in the Administrative Record File include the Action Memorandum, Sampling and Analytical Data, and Notices to Potentially Responsible Parties (PRP).
