This memorandum transmits Region I's request for your concurrence on a Nationally-Significant Removal Action at the Centredale Manor Site in North Providence, RI. This action is considered Nationally-Significant as it is a Fund-lead removal action at a non-NPL site involving dioxin as a principal contaminant (OSWER Directive 9360.0-19).

I recommend you concur on Region I's Action Memorandum. We have coordinated the review of the Action Memorandum and Enforcement Addendum with Marlene Berg to ensure compliance with OSWER Directive 9200.4-26, "Approach for Addressing Dioxin in Soil at CERCLA and RCRA Sites".
