o Technical Update

Anna updated the MAC on the progress of the field activities taking place at Centredale Manor. TTNUS has installed a dozen of groundwater monitoring wells and still needs to install four wells on Johnston side of the River as well as couple more wells on the Centredale and Brook Village property. Anna explained that some well locations has been adjusted based on preliminary results from the geophysical surveys which have been completed in June. Well installation will be followed by groundwater sampling and a report with results is expected in late Fall.

The Potentially Responsible Parties (PRPs) had submitted the Implementation Work Plan and 100% Design for review by EPA, RIDEM and COE. EPA expects to approve the design by July 25, 2001 and under the Order the PRPs would be required to start construction during first week in August. They also secured nearly all needed access to private properties.

USGS/ESE Harding is continuing collection of biota samples and that work is expected to continue until the end of July. Eugenia asked for more information regarding characterization of wetland area in the Lymanville reach of the River, below the Allendale Dam.

o Community Outreach Update

Anna told the MAC that she received a call from a reporter for North Star, a local weekly N. Providence newspaper, which will be publishing a story about current status of the Site in its next issue.

There was a discussion of Open house to be held on August 1, 2001. It was suggested that a MAC meeting was held at 4:00pm that day. Bill Sweet said that he will have a presentation stand for health-related dioxin issues. Do's and Don'ts for Woonasquatucket, etc. Eugenia explained that EPA needs to address concerns such as truck traffic routes and a potential for mobilizing sediment during Allendale Dam reconstruction through presentations.

o Other Items

The next meeting is scheduled for 4:00 pm in the Town Hall on August 1. Anna will distribute Table of Content for the Draft 100% Design and Implementation Work Plan prepared by Loureiro Engineering to MAC members.
