Dear Mr. Baccala,

Thank you for taking the time September 9th to meet with representatives from RIDEM and EPA to discuss the Superfund cleanup of the dioxin-contaminated Woonasquatucket River. As we discussed, a cleanup approach for the Centredale Manor Restoration Project has not been determined as of yet. Several general approaches for the sediment contamination are being considered ranging from capping the contamination in place to excavating and disposing the contamination, possibly using a mix of disposal approaches.

It was helpful to walk your property along the riverbank, gain a better understanding of your business operations, and discuss the project with you in an effort to assess whether your property could be impacted by any of the possible approaches being considered at this point. I am sorry we haven't connected by phone recently. Your phone message on the 15th indicated that you had an idea which you weren't sure would help us or not. Clearly, we would welcome any thoughts or suggestions you might have. Please don't hesitate to contact me at 617-918-1403.
