**Administrative Record File Addendum Available for the
Centredale Manor Restoration Project Site Removal Action**

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announces that the Administrative Record File Addendum for the removal action at the Centredale Manor Restoration Project Site located in Providence, Rhode Island is available for review. EPA seeks to inform the public of the availability of the Administrative Record File and to encourage the public to review and comment on it. Chain-link fencing was installed on the west bank of Allendale Pond in 2000 under the first Action Memorandum, to protect public health and to limit access to contaminated sediments. Subsequently, an increase in the water level caused the chain-link fence to submerge in several areas. Under this Action Memorandum Addendum, the fence has been relocated to the existing, stable shoreline. EPA contractors have removed and disposed of the submerged fencing and hardware; installed new chain-link fencing at the existing shoreline; and surveyed the new fence line. The relocated fence line will continue to restrict public access to contaminated sediments until a long-term remedy is in place.

The Administrative Record File is the collection of documents that formed the basis for the selection of a removal action at the site. Documents in the Administrative Record File include Action Memorandum Addendums.
