Introduction to the Collection

This is the Administrative Record for the Centredale Manor Restoration Project Site, North Providence, Rhode Island, Removal Action Addendum. This Administrative Record was compiled in December 2005 and subsequently released on CD-ROM in November 2010. This Administrative Record contains site-specific documents and a list of guidance documents used by EPA staff in selecting a removal action at the site.

Chain-link fencing was installed on the west bank of Allendale Pond in 2000 under the first Action Memorandum to protect public health and to limit access to contaminated sediments. Property owners abutting Allendale Pond had granted access and authorization to EPA for installation of the fencing. At that time, Allendale Dam had been breached for several years, lowering the historic water level in Allendale Pond.

During 2002, Allendale Dam was replaced by the EPA Remedial Program under an Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA). The dam replacement resulted in an increase of several feet in the water level, restoring historic water levels in Allendale Pond. However, the restored water level caused the chain-link fence to submerge in several areas. Under this Action Memorandum Addendum, the fence has been relocated to the existing, stable shoreline.

The Emergency Rapid Response Services (ERRS) contractors have conducted a site-walk with the EPA On-Scene Coordinator (OSC); mobilized appropriate equipment and personnel to the site; removed and disposal of the submerged fencing and hardware; installed new chain-link fencing at the existing shoreline; and surveyed the new fence line. The relocated fence line will continue to restrict public access to contaminated sediments until a long-term remedy is in place. Before work commenced, updated access agreements with the affected property owners were obtained.
