As a resident of Johnston who is on the boards of the Northern Rhode Island Conservation District and the Woonasquatucket River Watershed Council, I have followed your work on this Superfund Site for over 10 years. I deeply care about the clean up of this river, but never thought the proposed plan would be sending all that sediment soil to Johnston.

When Mayor Polisena first commented that making the Towns DPW land the upland (CDF) with stipulations could be a win-win for the Town. I considered supporting the plan. I still did not like the fact most of the sites you considered were directly over the Narragansett Bay Commission sewer interceptor or right beside it.

After reading a copy of the letter Mayor Polisena sent you December 29th. I have concluded I feel as he does making upland disposal in Johnston is not acceptable.
