RESOLUTION to adopt the "Ashton-Pratt Corridor Redevelopment Plan"

7 Be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Cumberland as follows:

8

9 **Whereas:** The Towns of Cumberland and Lincoln, Rhode Island were awarded a one
10 hundred thousand (\$100,000) dollar grant by the Environmental Protection Agency for
11 the research, preparation and presentation of a Land Use Redevelopment Plan for the
12 Peterson/Puritan, Inc. Superfund Site; and,

13

14 **Whereas:** the Towns of Cumberland and Lincoln hired the firm of Crossman
15 Engineering to facilitate this process and draft the Plan; and,

16

17 **Whereas:** public consensus was generated through several public workshops,
18 meetings and interviews with stakeholders and interested Town citizens, organizations
19 and administrative staff; and,

20

21 **Whereas:** the recommendations contained in the Plan are reasonable and recognize
22 both the historic growth patterns and the future needs of the Town of Cumberland; and

23

24 **Whereas:** this Plan provides the Environmental Protection Agency with the
25 information needed to assist in properly establishing cleanup standards and design
26 appropriate protective remedies for reuse and continued use of the land in and adjacent to
27 the Superfund site.

29 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of
30 Cumberland, as follows:

31

32 **Section 1.** THE CUMBERLAND TOWN COUNCIL HEREBY ADOPTS THE
33 ATTACHED DOCUMENT TITLED ASHTON - PRATT CORRIDOR
34 REDEVELOPMENT PLAN AND DIRECTS THE TOWN ADMINISTRATION TO
35 FOLLOW THROUGH WITH THE PLAN'S IMPLEMENTATION.

37 **Section 2.** THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE
38 IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS PASSAGE BY THE CUMBERLAND TOWN COUNCIL.
