The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) in a letter dated June 17, 2011 gave Notice of Oil Recovery Directive for Summer 2011 with a work plan due date of June 24, 2011. However, since receiving this letter, findings from the recent Morrow Lake poling activities result in a recommended change in sequencing of the summer work activities and the inclusion of Morrow Lake into the submerged oil recovery work.

In a meeting (yesterday) with the U.S. EPA, Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership's (Enbridge) gave a briefing of the current status of the Morrow Lake submerged oil and recommended to postpone the final 2011 Summer Strategic Work Plan so that this area could be sufficiently incorporated into the plan. At the conclusion of the briefing, you verbally agreed to a new due date of June 29, 2011 for the final work plan and have an interim draft 2011 Summer Strategic Work Plan submitted today so preliminary review could begin on the other areas addressed in the plan.

Therefore, Enbridge is submitting the Interim Draft 2011 Summer Strategic Work Plan for your initial review. The final 2011 Summer Strategic Work Plan will be delivered on Wednesday, June 29, 2011.
