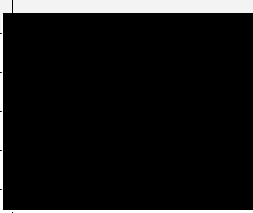

Activity	SOTF#4 Tikvael Sulaiman (START), Enbridge Team Lead Kelly Lemke, and Leica operator Jackie performed poling and delineation at 46 locations in focus areas 5.75S, 5.55N, 5.35N, 2.55N, 3.30S, 5.25N, 5.63S, 5.75NW and 5.25S. A total of 4 locations had an overall submerged oil category of heavy (focus areas 5.75NW and 5.55N), 15 locations had an overall submerged oil category of moderate (focus areas 5.75NW, 5.55N, 5.25S and 5.63S), 19 locations had an overall submerged oil category of light, and 5 locations had no oil sheen or globs observed. All locations poled passed the temperature requirements of 60 degrees F. Sediment temperatures ranged from 61.19 to 66.25 degrees F, above sediment temperatures ranged from 63.17 to 71.63 degrees F, and surface water temperatures ranged from 63.17 to 76.85 degrees F.
