Activity		<p><u>START SOTF Team 7 Activity:</u></p> <p>START SOTF 7 and MDEQ (Paul Clarke) conducted oversight documentation of Enbridge Team G (Mike Bigsby and Keith Payne). Team G conducted poling, Secchi disk measurements and water / sediment temperature readings on Morrow Lake at the forty designated poling locations. All target points were above sixty degrees.</p> <p>Poling Location:</p> <p>Designated poling location in Morrow lake. Twenty-four of the forty locations were poled today. This completed the 40 designated poling locations on the lake. Sheen and globules were observed at E 4.0 boat launch and on the downstream side of E 4.0 hard boom. The poling was conducted from MP 38.00 to 38.50. The lake had high winds (15-20 mph) out of the South. The boats would anchor at each point and poling was done between the boats. Wind and waves were blocked by the upwind boat so the sheen and globules could be observed during the poling. Note: Enbridge will be adding 20 more designated locations on Morrow lake.</p>						

	<p>Summary of poling results for the target locations:</p> <p>Morrow Lake had a total of twenty-four locations poled. 4 of 24 locations with nothing, 19 of 24 locations with lights, 1 of 24 locations had moderates, 0 of 24 locations had heavies.</p> <p>Weather: Morning 66 degrees, sunny and winds 10-15 mph out of the South. Afternoon 75 degrees, sunny with 15-20 mph out of the South.</p>
