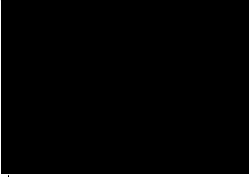

Activity		<u>Weston/START Submerged Oil Branch Task Force Group (SOTF) Team Activity:</u> SOTF#2 Jonathan Roubik (START), Team Lead Roy Wagner, and Leica operator Eric Celebreeze performed (or attempted) poling at 22 locations in focus areas HBP, 7.65N, 7.75, 8.25I, 9.00I, 9.45T, 9.50N, 9.75SB. Poling activities had 1 location (9.00I2-B-10) that produced an overall submerged oil category of heavy sheen concentration. This area was delineated with poling of additional points. 3 locations produced moderate sheen (9.75SB-B-05, 9.45T-B-08, and 9.50N-B-02D). 10 locations produced an overall submerged oil category of light sheen and 8 locations produced no sheen. 15 locations was poled for bathometry data only. Data for all sites was collected following a temperate reading that passed the temperature requirements WITH THE EXCEPTION OF 9.50N (sediment temperatures was 57.4) In all other areas sediment temperatures ranged from 60.4 to 67.0 degrees F, above sediment temperatures ranged from 60.4 to 66.3 degrees F, and surface water temperatures ranged from 60.3 to 65.6 degrees F.
