Activity	<u>START SOTF Team 5 Activity:</u> Brennan Pierce (START) observed SOTF5 team members (led by Weldon Evans of Tetra Tech) conduct poling at 74 locations in the Morrow Lake Delta. Of the 74 locations, 8 had submerged oil category of 'None', 28 were 'Light', 31 were 'Moderate', and 7 were 'Heavy'. Water surface temperatures ranged from 65 degrees Fahrenheit to 73. Temperature above sediment ranged from 64 to 73. Sediment temperatures ranged from 58 to 67. 9 poling locations did not meet the minimum temperature requirements for all three parameters.
