Of the 38 locations, 12 had submerged oil category of 'None', 22 were 'Light', 3 were 'Moderate', and 1 was 'Heavy'. Water surface temperatures ranged from 61 degrees Fahrenheit to 71. Temperature above sediment ranged from 62 to 72. Sediment temperatures ranged from 57 to 69.
