Activity	<p>SOTF#4 Kristen Hendrix (START), Enbridge Team Lead Frank Ronguillo, and Leica operator Chad Khodl performed poling delineation at 36 locations from MP 22.25 to MP 29.10. A total of 1 location had an overall submerged oil category of heavy (27.90-05B), 7 locations had an overall submerged oil category of moderate, 12 locations had an overall submerged oil category of light, 7 locations had no oil sheen or globs observed, 8 locations were dry, and 1 location was inaccessible due to fallen trees and debris (22.75N-I-15).</p> <p>All locations poled passed the temperature requirements of 60 degrees F. Sediment temperatures ranged from 60.6 to 70.1 degrees F, above sediment temperatures ranged from 65.8 to 70.8 degrees F, and surface water temperatures ranged from 66.0 to 70.8 degrees F.</p>
