Activity	<p>SOTF #9 Kristen Hendrix (START), Enbridge Team Lead Frank Ronguillo, and Leica operator Brad Parlato performed poling at 42 locations from MP 27.50 to 35.10 that had previously failed the temperature requirements. A total of 3 locations had an overall submerged oil category of heavy, 3 location had an overall submerged oil category of moderate, 19 locations had an overall submerged oil category of light, 8 locations had an overall submerged oil category of none, and 9 locations were dry. SOTF-9 also visited 12 bathymetry locations.</p> <p>All locations poled passed the temperature requirements of 60 degrees F. Sediment temperatures ranged from 61.1 to 71.8 degrees F, above sediment temperatures ranged from 64.5 to 73.5 degrees F, and surface water temperatures ranged from 64.5 to 74.0 degrees F.</p>
