Mr. Hansen utilizes a Stream Probe mounted on floats equipped with GPS instrumentation and electronic data collector. Areas visited today utilizing kayaks included East Michigan Ave bridge in Augusta, Creek at approximately MP29.25, 35th St. bridge was also accessed by kayak due to a crew of painters working on the downstream guardrail. Area accessed via land included a creek running across M96 near 38th St. in Augusta and Galesburg city limits, measurements were taken at the residence to the north due to railroad tracks running over creek at the downstream side.</p>
