	Paul Moisan (START) observed SOTF7 team members (led by Russell Pratt of AECOM) conduct poling at 29 locations in Morrow Lake, and 5 locations in the Delta. Of the 29 locations in Morrow Lake, 27 had submerged oil category of 'Light' and 2 were 'Moderate.' In the Delta, 3 had a category of 'light' and 2 had a category of 'moderate.' Sediment temperatures ranged from 73.7 degrees Fahrenheit to 80.9. Temperature above sediment ranged from 78.0 to 84.3. Surface temperatures ranged from 80.1 to 86.4.
