Activity	<u>START SOTF Team #3 Activity:</u> SOS # 3 conducted oversight of the Agitation Study Team. Team utilized a YUMA/GPS instrument to navigate to a specific point. An existing stake was verified as the point to perform the agitation. A prefabricated steel box with two open ends was placed over the center of the stake, wooden platforms were installed around the steel box for workers access. Sheen net samples, turbidity samples, water samples, core samples and Lsst/Lias samples were taken prior to the agitation. Post agitation, turbidity monitoring occurred at the 0:00 hr, 0:15 hr, 0:30 hr, 1:00 hr, 2:00 hr, 4:00 hr and 6:00 hr intervals. Sheen net, water, core and Lsst/lia samples were taken.
