Transect B was partially completed on Monday, September 10th and is completed as Tuesday, September 11th. Transect C is comprised of one hundred six (106) locations spread four (4) feet apart. Information of each location includes location identification, water depth, water velocity and comments. Transect C was completed. All locations in Transect C were considered a dry area or saturated soils. Transect E is comprised of ninety-seven (97) locations. Transect E was completed. All locations in Transect E were dry or saturated soil. Transect F was completed, thirty eight (38) locations total, sixteen (16) were under water and the remaining were documented as dry or saturated soils. Started bathymetry documentation at MP 33.0B. Thirty three (33) locations were documented, twenty four (24) were under water.</p>
