On October 24, 2012, Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership (Enbridge) issued a letter to further discuss the comments received from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) on the 2012 Morrow Lake Delta and Morrow Lake Monitoring and Management Work Plan (Plan). The intent was to have a final approved Plan completed by November 5, 2012.

Since that time, both parties, Enbridge and U.S. EPA representatives have met to discuss finalizing the Plan. Currently, a revised draft Plan is under review with U.S. EPA representatives. In addition, there is also consideration of altering the bathymetry section of the Plan pending a Focus group meeting scheduled for November 6, 2012.

Therefore, we are proposing a revised submission date of November 9, 2012 to complete the approved Plan.
