Activity		<p><u>START CBR Team 1 Activity:</u></p> <p>START CBR 1 conducted oversight of Enbridge Team of Eric Celebrezze (Team Lead). Enbridge teams of Eric Celebrezze and Luke Hodges (oversight by Sean Kane) were at the sediment trap locations MP10.4 and 10.5. Pulled the CSDs at MP 10.5 and put them back after the days work. Once they got the base station set up and the backshots taken, Eric's team went ahead of Luke's team and set up the bathymetry transects at MP-10.5 so that the other team didn't have to keep stopping to set up new transects. Once we finished at MP-10.5, Eric went to MP-10.4 and setup a new temporary base station and completed the backshots and then we setup two transects. Then the other team completed the bathymetry measurements and Eric's team and Luke's team completed the backshots. They worked until 1700 because they couldn't get the second of two backshots to be below the 0.02 accuracy, They tried over ten times but it got to be 1700 and Eric said o stop so the boats could get off the water.
