In the morning Ted went with another Enbridge team and Marcin went with another Enbridge team to get training on the Trimble. I met up with Ted at MP-33.00A/B after completing the other work I had at C3.2 for core logging/sampling. Following the training, Ted and his team met up at MP-21.50 to begin setup at this sediment trap. The boats met us at a small launch site just south of MP-21.5 and Marcin rode the boats over to MP-21.5 and Ted and I drove to the construction office just east of the 21.5 sediment trap. They got the transect lines set up on the island portion of the sediment trap 21.5. However, they setup the base station and were trying to get the back shot collected and the Trimble unit would only read out minutes, seconds degrees and not X,Y,Z. They trouble shot for a while and called for assistance but they could not figure it out. They finished for the day and will begin again in the morning.
